CAMP DESCRIPTION

Agua Caliente is a primitive campout in the Borrego Desert that is known for its amazing beauty. The Kumeyaay Indians call this secluded oasis “hot water” because of its unique, naturally heated springs.

Agua Caliente is a two-hour drive from San Diego. There are many places to explore during your weekend adventure. Desert hiking trails, nearby mud caves, and historical sites are all part of the Agua experience.

Weather varies depending on the time of year
Pack for varied temps.

AMENITIES

This is a primitive campout. All sites have a fire ring, grilling grate, and picnic table. Amenities such as water and electricity will vary depending on the sites reserved for your weekend.

Please see your Nation Y-Space for suggested packing lists. You should coordinate food and necessary cooking supplies with your tribe.

Please contact your tribe chief or event host if you plan to bring an RV. Tribal site assignments will be made in advance.

CAMP HIGHLIGHTS - Weekend activities vary by group

- Great for biking (helmets required)
- Horseshoes
- Visit the mud caves nearby
- Ranger-led nature programs
- Great for hiking (Explore the many desert hiking trails. Mud caves are a short drive away.)
- Stargazing
- Shuffleboard
- Children’s play area
- Small general store (located just outside the park entrance for sodas and ice cream)
