CAMP DESCRIPTION

Death Valley National Park is the land of extremes. From Badwater Basin the lowest point in North America to Dante’s View, a mountain overlook 5000 ft above the inferno of the valley; this national park is the hottest, driest and lowest. Explore the Devil’s Golf Course, filled with rock salt eroded by wind and rain into jagged spires that “only the devil could play golf on such rough links” or take a hike to the natural bridge crossing the desert canyon. Take a day trip to Scotty’s Castle, the elaborate Spanish-style mansion built in the 1920’s or just keep it rugged in the desert. You may even take a break from hiking and go for a swim and shower at the Furnace Creek Ranch. Pack your low profile tent, in case of wind.
