CAMP DESCRIPTION

Nestled in the rolling hills of Winchester, beautiful Lake Skinner Recreational Area offers wide-open natural vistas and invigorating recreational opportunities, including camping, picnicking, hiking, horseback riding, sailing, and fishing. Located just a few short miles east of Temecula, Lake Skinner has a 6-mile hiking trail around the park perimeter, two playgrounds and lots of grassy areas for nation activities.

Weather varies depending on the time of year. Pack for varied temps.

AMENITIES

Campsites provide plenty of space for both tents and RVs, with water and electricity. Showers and restrooms nearby. Sites offers picnic benches and fire rings. A well-stocked camp store sells grocery items, bait & tackle, ice, firewood, and various snacks. The camp store marina offers boat rentals (year round).
