CAMP DESCRIPTION

Pine Summit is known for its resort style amenities. Located in Big Bear Lake, CA, at 7,000 feet, the area is rich with pine and oak forests which flourish in an alpine environment. The area provides a natural habitat for approximately 30 wintering bald eagles and 29 species of rare plants. Stay closer to home and feel you've traveled thousands of miles away.

Pine Summit offers several different lodging variations. Each of the lodging accommodations provides all the comforts of home! You'll find the floor plan in each room or cabin to have plenty of variety including a combination of bed styles from bunk beds, to twins, to super comfortable queen size beds; all linens included! Amidst all the fun and excitement, you could find yourself craving a snack or even a delicious iced coffee. There is a snack shop which is centrally located and offers a quiet lounge area inside and out that are perfect for sipping coffee and hanging out.

HIGHLIGHTS

Activity options range from; intermediate ropes course, archery, BB rifles, zip lines, climbing wall, bungee run, Jacob's Ladder Challenge, Human Foosball, and so much more.
