CAMP DESCRIPTION

Try the 96-foot tall indoor skydiving wind tunnel. This adventure is ideal for all ages and skill levels. You will enjoy the sensation of free falling without the scary jump out of an airplane! Once you're floating on the chamber's powerful column of air, you'll become familiar with the art of indoor skydiving in just a few minutes.

The skydiving wind tunnel is a pressurized room with 2 compartments; the chamber, where the wind flows, and the antechamber, which is the waiting room. Typical flying sessions are between one and two minutes in length. Small groups typically share 30 to 60 minutes.

A certified instructor supervises each group. Tunnel flying does vary slightly from skydiving. The air flow is manually controlled to suit your body size and experience.

A Perris Valley Skydiving instructor will be available at all times to help you with proper flying techniques.

GEAR – Every flyer is required to wear a jumpsuit, a helmet and earplugs during indoor skydiving.

DIRECTIONS

To Perris Skyventure Indoor Skydiving from San Diego:

- Take 15 (N) to 215 (N).
- Exit Ethanac West.
- Dead ends at Goetz Rd, turn right.
- The airport is 1.5 miles on the right.
- Look for the large airplane wing at the entrance.
